



100 Colours Blanket

This stunning blanket uses 100 different shades for a striking and colourful centrepiece to any room.



ADD TO THE STASH

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MATERIALS

- Yarn and Colours Must-Have, 100% cotton, 50g/125m/136yds
Yarn A: Cream 002 x 4 balls
- Yarn and Colours Must-Have Minis, 100% cotton, 10g/25m/27yds
Shades: All shades x 1 ball
- 3mm hook

YARN ALTERNATIVES

Use any fingering weight cotton to achieve a similar effect.

TENSION

Work one octagon motif to measure 7.5cm/3in from one long side to another after blocking, using 3mm hook, or size required to obtain tension.

You will need to make two motifs from each mini-ball so be sure to check tension before beginning.

MEASUREMENTS

Finished blanket measures 145 x 85cm/57¼ x 33½in.

SPECIAL STITCHES

Foundation double crochet

(fdc): Insert hook in lower loop of previous dc and work 1dc.

1ch, fdc: 1ch, turn this 1ch a quarter turn, insert hook in upstanding back loop then work fdc.

PATTERN NOTES

This stunning blanket uses all 100 different colours of the Must-Have Minis.

The octagons have four longer and four smaller sizes. In between the octagons small cream-coloured motifs are worked to fill the openings. A small border finishes this design and fills out the remaining openings at the sides as well.

There are 18 rows with 11 motifs for each row. The smaller cream motifs are added at the end.

Use all 100 colours to make the octagons. Almost every colour is used twice, since there is a total of



198 octagons in this blanket. Combine octagons randomly.

Start with the upper row, and work downwards, row by row. Work each row from left to right side.

Row 1: The first octagon is on the upper left side. The second octagon is joined as you go to the first one, when crocheting the last motif round. The joining is worked in two 1ch-sp, next to a long side of the motif.

The third octagon is attached to the second, making sure that every joined motif has a "long free side" on the upper side and downside. Finish the first row, joining new octagons to the previous ones.

Row 2: Work from left side to right side. The first octagon of this row is joined to the bottom long side of the first motif of Row 1. The second octagon of this row is attached to the bottom side of the second motif of Row 1, next to the first motif of the second row. Continue for the entire row.

Rows 3–18: As Row 2.

Always work on RS. Do not turn.

The joined places are indicated in colour on the charts.

START **ROW 1**
OCTAGON 1
Make an adjustable ring.
Rnd 1: (RS) 3ch, 11tr in ring, sl st to third ch to join – 12tr.
Rnd 2: (RS) 3ch (counts as 1tr here and throughout) 1tr in same sp, 2tr in next tr, 1ch, 1tr, 1ch, *(2tr in next tr) twice, 1ch, 1tr, 1ch; rep from * twice more, sl st to third

ch to join – 20tr, 8 x 1ch-sp.

Rnd 3: 3ch, 1tr in same sp, 3tr, (1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in ch-sp, 1tr, *(1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in ch-sp, 4tr, (1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in next ch-sp, 1tr; rep from * twice more, (1tr, 1ch) in last ch-sp, sl st in third ch to join – 36tr, 8 x 1ch-sp.

Rnd 4: 3ch, 1tr in same sp, 5tr, (1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in ch-sp, 3tr, *(1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in ch-sp, 6tr, (1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in ch-sp, 3tr; rep from * twice more, (1tr, 1ch) in last ch-sp, sl st in third ch to join – 52tr, 8 x 1ch-sp.

Cut yarn and fasten off.

Weave in ends.

OCTAGON 2

Rnds 1–3: As Octagon 1.

Rnd 4: 3ch, 1tr in same sp, 5tr, (1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in ch-sp, 3tr, *(1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in ch-sp, 6tr, (1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in ch-sp, 3tr; rep from * once more, 1tr in next (sixth) ch-sp, join with sl st to any ch-sp of Octagon 1 (next to a long side, making sure there is a second ch-sp at other side of long side for second joining

place), 1tr in same ch-sp, next work over long side of octagon working 8tr, 1tr in next (seventh) ch-sp, join with sl st in the other ch-sp next to long side of Octagon 1, 3tr, (1tr, 1ch) in last ch-sp, sl st in third ch to join – 52tr, 8 x 1ch-sp.

Cut yarn and fasten off.

Weave in all ends.

OCTAGONS 3–11

Rnds 1–3: As Octagon 1.

Rnd 4: As Octagon 2, leaving upper and lower long side of each octagon unjoined.


Weave in all ends.


ROW 2

OCTAGON 1

Rnds 1–3: As Row 1 Octagon 1.

Rnd 4: 3ch, 1tr in same sp, 5tr, (1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in ch-sp, 3tr, *(1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in next ch-sp, 6tr, (1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in next ch-sp, 3tr; rep from * once more, 1tr in sixth ch-sp, join with sl st to Row 1 Octagon 1 in 1ch-sp at bottom right next to long side,





1tr in same 1ch-sp, 6tr, 1tr in seventh ch-sp, join with sl st in other ch-sp of long side of Row 1 Octagon 1, 3tr, (1tr, 1ch) in last ch-sp, sl st in third ch to join. Cut yarn and fasten off – 52tr, 8 x 1ch-sps.

OCTAGON 2

Rnds 1-3: As Row 1 Octagon 1.

Rnd 4: 3ch, 1tr in same sp, 5tr, (1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in first ch-sp, 3tr, (1tr,

1ch, 1tr) in next ch-sp, 6tr, (1tr, 1ch, 1tr) in next ch-sp, 3tr, 1tr in fourth ch-sp, join with sl st to Octagon 2 of Row 1 in ch-sp at bottom right, 1tr in same fourth ch-sp, 6tr, 1tr in fifth ch-sp, join with sl st in other ch-sp on long side of Octagon 2 Row 1, 1tr in same fifth ch-sp, 3tr, 1tr in sixth ch-sp, sl st to ch-sp of Octagon 1 Row 2, 1tr in same sixth ch-sp, 6tr, 1tr in seventh ch-sp, sl st in next
